The project investigates patterns of participation in global internet governance institutions such as the Internet Governance Forum (IGF). You will help collecting data on the country of origin and other characteristics of participants in the IGF. This data will be used to study imbalances in participation such as between countries, private and public actors, or civil society organizations and corporations.
